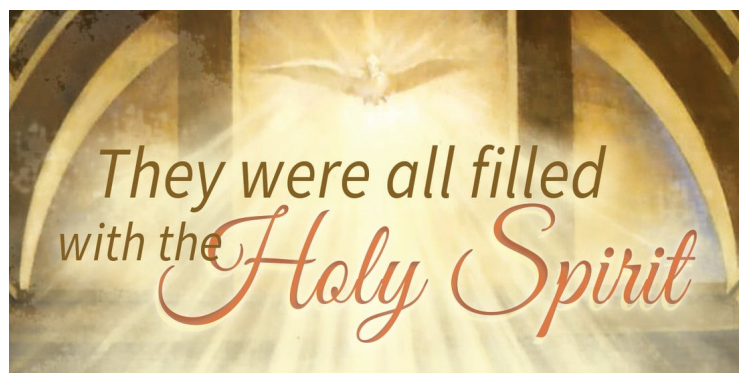


St. Michael Prayer
