

- Include your return address on each letter you write and ask for a response so that even if the letters are split up during sorting the recipient of the letter can write back if they wish (though there is no guarantee that they will).
- Please drop all letters in the appropriate boxes at each site of worship <u>NO LATER THAN NOV. 12. DO NOT PUT</u> <u>YOUR LETTTERS IN AN ENVELOPE</u>. They must be mailed without individual envelopes.
- We will bundle the letters together and send them to a National Mail Intake Facility for "A Million Thanks" where they will be sorted and distributed to our service men and service women.
- This effort will cost you little or no money, but will put smiles on many faces all over the world!
- If you would like to further support our efforts, donations will be accepted for postage. Include any donations in the box with your letters.
